Celebrated as one of the most popular and path-breaking novels of its time, it has received continual critical acclaim: the Rabindra Puraskar (the Tagore Prize) in 1966 and the Bharatiya Jnanpith, India's highest literary award, in 1977. The plot was woven in the backdrop of the Bay of Bengal waters near Kanthi region of United Bengal. At that time, according to Bengal's geological history, the seas had closed in towards that region to accommodate the confluence of rivers. 'Kapalakundala' is a romantic novel, with terrible events and sub-plots. The plots move very fast, reaching natural consequences, though supernatural situations drop in to add charm to the episodes. The novel has highly poetic grace, tinged with pithy irony in a bland prosaic structure.
