The present work is focused on the mathematical and computational theory behind a technique for deformable image registration termed Hyperelastic Warping, and demonstration of the technique via applications in image registration and strain measurement. The approach combines well-established principles of nonlinear continuum mechanics with forces derived directly from three-dimensional image data to achieve registration. The general approach does not require the definition of landmarks, fiducials, or surfaces, although it can accommodate these if available. Representative problems demonstrate the robust and flexible nature of the approach. Three-dimensional registration methods are introduced for registering MRI volumes of the pelvis and prostate.
