These obstacles may become reminders of the triumphs and failures of a young man's experience, trying to incorporate the wisdom that his older compatriots offer him. The writer's poetic influences lie heavily with the American Modernists. Some poets become characters or subjects within poems. The idea of creating a world within a poem stems from the rejection of tradition posed by the Modernists. Some of these created worlds hold Romantic ideals of grandeur, but most are simple alternatives to an alienating society. A piece like "Don't Feed the Sea Lions," suggests that there are negative consequences to creating your own poetic world. It's easy to get lost or to bring abstract ideas to reality.
